Swap and Shop 1947

Swap and Shop has been on the WGNS Airwaves since 1947. The program is a reminder of what local radio should be, connecting residents one phone call at a time.

During the Swap and Shop program, listeners call or text the WGNS Studio "LIVE" with items they have to sell or trade. They also call in with items they want to buy.

Swap and Shop airs Monday through Friday from 7:50AM to 8:10AM. The program is heard on FM 100.5, FM 101.9, AM 1450 and our streaming apps that are available for free in the iTunes or Google Play stores or on the WGNSradio.com website.

During the Swap and Shop program, your business will receive one commercial per day Monday — Friday. The 30-second commercial will air between calls each morning. The commercial can be read "LIVE" by the daily host or can be prerecorded.
